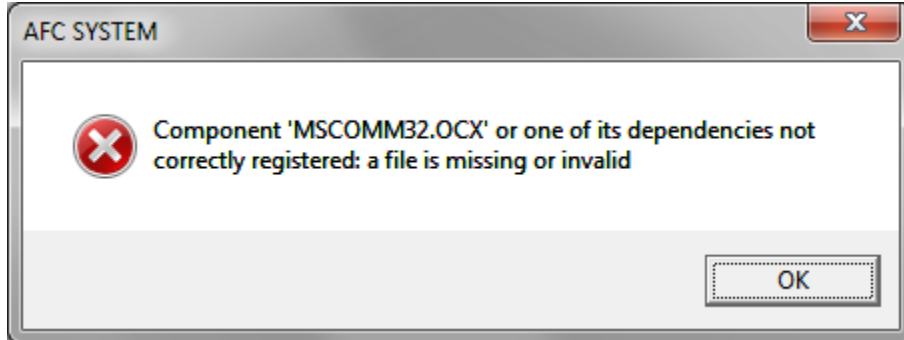




Installing AFC Software on Windows Vista or Windows 7 both 32 and 64 bit editions.

When installing AFC / DSP software onto a computer running Windows Vista or Windows 7, the following error may come up when you try to launch the program.



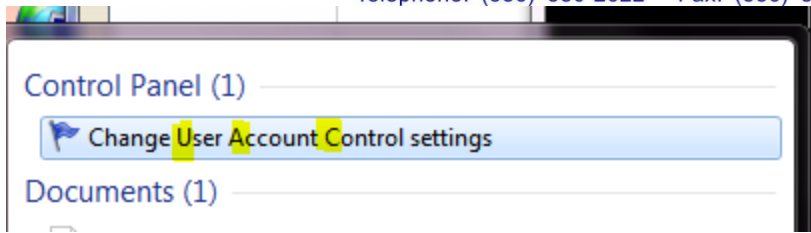
The first time you run the AFC / DSP software in Windows Vista or Windows 7, you need to right click on the AFC / DSP launch icon and select "Run as Administrator". (This is a new function of Windows Vista & Windows 7). This will register the AFC software files necessary to run the next time you launch the software. Once you do this, it should run as normal.

If the right click "Run as Administrator" doesn't work then try these steps.

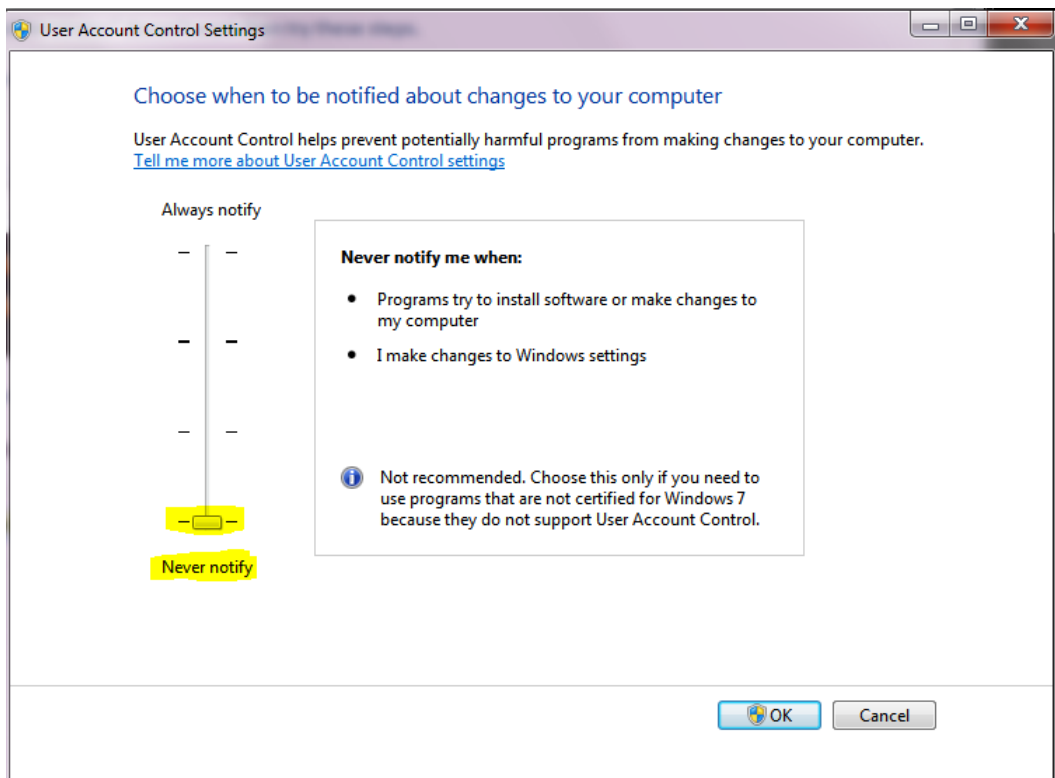
Click start then in the search programs and files area type 'uac' which will give you a quick shortcut to get to

Once in UAC settings screen make a note of where the slider bar is set at. Typically it's one click down from the top. Change this to the bottom by dragging the bar to the bottom setting of 'Never notify'.



This procedure will require a reboot. Once you've rebooted, try to run the AFC or DSP software. You need to *right* click on the AFC / DSP launch icon and select "Run as Administrator". If the errors are gone you should change the UAC setting back to its previous setting and reboot again. Upon reboot, verify that the AFC or DSP software now runs properly without any errors.

IF the error still persists we recommend turning the UAC setting back to 'Never notify', rebooting and then try to uninstall then reinstall the software. *Right* click on the AFC / DSP launch icon and select "Run as Administrator". If this works, set UAC back to its previous setting and reboot. Upon reboot, verify once again if the AFC or DSP software runs without error.
